Dear parents and carers

Homework is an important element of our learning programmes here at Carrington School and when it is approached with enthusiasm and commitment it adds a great deal of value to students' final outcomes.

At this early point in the school year we have issued all students with information about when they can expect homework and how much time they should be spending on it. We also like to remind parents and carers that having your support in ensuring your young people make time to complete these tasks properly, is key to their success.

Students and parents can keep track of exactly what tasks have been set, by whom, and when they are due to be handed in, using the Go4Schools app linked to your [Go4Schools account](#). If an aspect of a homework task is not clear, students should email the teacher in question for help, or seek them out in school to get more guidance in good time BEFORE the deadline.
