Places on trips are limited to ensure that we can staff them safely and to make sure the school does not incur financial losses. If demand is high, we will attempt to increase capacity.

Payments for high value trips will divided into instalments, with a non-refundable deposit payment. If you fall behind with payments and do not contact us to arrange an extension, the place may be offered to the next on the waiting list.
