Dear parents and carers

This morning in assembly I was excited to offer Year 10s a fantastic opportunity to participate in a ski trip during the Easter break 2024. We will be travelling to Sestriere on the border of Italy and France and will be partnering with a highly reputable ski company SelectSki, who specialise in school ski trips to Europe.

We will be departing on **Saturday 30 March** and returning on **Saturday 6 April 2024**.

We anticipate demand will be high and there is a limited number of places, so please take careful note of the process for requesting a place on this trip:

Step 1

Request a place by submitting [THIS REQUEST FORM](#), which will become **live at 18:00 hours on Monday 15 May**

- The link is not accessible until that time
- Your submission will be date and time stamped
- Places will be allocated to the first 43 respondents; after this, applicants will be registered on a Waiting List
- We will notify you by email on **Thursday 18 May** if you have been allocated one of these 43 places or not

Step 2

If you are allocated a place you need to secure it by paying the non-refundable deposit. ParentPay will be opened only to those who are allocated a place on **Thursday 18 May**, and you will have **2 weeks to pay your deposit**.

Payment

The full cost of the trip is £1100. This includes all travel, accommodation in a “ski in – ski out” hotel, ski boots, poles & helmets along with the lift pass for the whole resort, not to mention 5 hours tuition a day for 5 days. The meals package comprises a buffet-style breakfast, a hot lunch on the mountain and three course meal in the evening. Included within the price are the local tourist tax and travel insurance.

Payment 1 £190 by 1 July

Payment 2 £190 by 1 August

Payment 3 £190 by 1 September

Payment 4 £190 by 1 October

Payment 5 £190 by 1 November
