Another Chance to Provide Consent for Year 9 Vaccinations

The Immunisation Team came into school on **12 May** and are returning on **27 May and 7 July** to carry out these vaccinations.

If you haven't yet done so, there is time now to provide your consent for this.

You can state which vaccines you would like [SHORTSTUDENTNAME] to receive. If you do not want them to receive a vaccine, then please fill in the 'NO' box.

Please complete the e-consent form by **Wednesday 25 May when the portal will close**. This allows time for their nurses to review and contact parents and carers if there are any concerns, prior to the session.

An automated email will be sent to you on completion of the e-consent from Cinnamon Digital Applications who host the website portal for us. If you do not receive this, please check in your junk or spam email or contact the Immunisation Team.

- **Diphtheria/Tetanus/Polio** final school booster protects against diphtheria, tetanus and polio. This vaccination will complete the baby injections given pre-school.
- **Meningococcal ACWY** protects against the four strains of meningitis known as ACWY. These diseases are known to affect older adolescents, especially if they go to university or training where they are living in accommodation with other young people.
