Dear Year 11 parents and carers

Year 11 have Mock Exams Coming Up

As you may be aware from the [School Calendar](#), our **Year 11 students** will be doing **Mock Exams** for the **fortnight beginning 8 November**.

All students received the full Mock Exam timetable by email last week. The timetable is downloadable from the school [website HERE](#). It has been uploaded as a Word document so that students can edit it, deleting the subjects that don't apply to them and creating a personalised timetable. The mock exams commence on **Monday 8 November**, providing students with valuable practice towards their actual GCSE exams in the summer term.

- These exams will take place in the same exam hall that we will use for the real ones in May and June, in conditions that closely represent the official exam expectations
- During the mock exam fortnight lessons will run as normal, meaning that when students are not in an exam they will follow their usual timetable, attending their usual lessons
- Where they have an afternoon exam (period 7) they will be able to come home as soon as that period 7 exam has finished to prepare for their next exam
- While the mock exams are going on general homework will be suspended to support students with their time management but some teachers may set exam-specific work to do at home
