Year 7 CAT Results

Your young person has **today been given a report explaining their CATs results.**

Pages 2-4 describe the different skill categories tested and provide a brief description of what they mean. **[SHORTSTUDENTNAME]'s actual results are on Page 5**, with a diagram showing the relative performance in each skill area followed by a summary, in words, including some strategies your young person should employ to progress through their school career.

Page 6 includes grade estimates for the end of Key Stage 4. These estimates have been used to set academic targets. These targets will be reported on future interim reports and will be available in Go4Schools.

As you know, to further improve the targeted support our teachers are able to give our Year 7 students, we are changing the structure of classes on Monday to match Years 8 and 9. The structure will consist of three extension sets and 4 mixed ability sets. **Your young person will also be given a new timetable with the CATs reports. These timetables will be available on Go4Schools from Monday.** The class lists have been decided using assessment data and input from the subject teachers, combined with information from the CATs tests.

In case you have any questions or concerns regarding CATs results, class changes, targets or interim reports, **we are running an information webinar at 6pm on Wednesday 24 November** to explain the key points with regard to those topics. An invitation link will be sent closer to the webinar date.
