Dear parents and carers

As a reminder, on **Friday 24 May**, students are invited to come to school wearing their **own clothes in exchange for a £1 donation**. If your young person chooses not to make the donation, they should come to school wearing their uniform that day. In the event that a student arrives in own-clothes without £1 to donate, we will be asking parents to facilitate their return home to get changed into their uniforms.

Note that 11s who are sitting their French GCSE exam on Friday morning WILL NEED TO BE IN UNIFORM, but can change, or "relax" their uniform, once they come out of that exam.

Please ensure that your young person dresses appropriately for school on Friday, noting the non-uniform guidance below.

<p>The School Uniform and Jewellery policies still apply. Students should come to school dressed in a neat and tidy manner with acceptable length skirts. If your young person has PE they must still bring PE kit to change into.</p>
