We anticipate demand will be high and there is a **limited number of places**, so please take careful note of the process for requesting a place on this trip:

### Step 1

**Request a place by submitting [THIS REQUEST FORM](#), which will become live at 6:00pm on Monday 25 November.**

- The link is not accessible until that time
- Your submission will be date and time stamped
- Places will be allocated to the **first 30** respondents; after this, applicants will be registered on a Waiting List
- The form will close at 9:30am on Wednesday 27 November
- **We will notify you by email if you have been allocated one of these 30 places** on Wednesday 27 November

## Step 2

If you are allocated a place, you need to secure it by paying the deposit. ParentPay will be opened only to those who are allocated a place, on Wednesday, and you will have a week to pay your deposit.

## Payment

The full cost of the trip is **£362**, which includes travel from the school by coach, insurance, all day and evening activities, accommodation and all meals (except for those for the journey there).
