ELECTION OF A PARENT GOVERNOR

There is a Parent Governor vacancy on the Carrington School Governing Body, and we would welcome applications to take on the role.

The role of the school governor is both rewarding to the individual and invaluable to the school. You would need to be supportive of the values of the school and the Trust and be able to give time and effort to the role, but no specific qualifications or experience are required, and support and training can be provided.

The Carrington School Governing Body is made up of 16 Governors, with 1 Staff Governor, 4 Parent Governors and Co-opted Governors who are persons appointed by the Governing Body itself.

To be a Parent Governor you must have parental responsibility for, or fulltime caring responsibility for, a registered pupil at the school on 31 January 2025.

School governors have to abide by certain rules regarding the role and their conduct and are expected to attend and take an active part in Governing Body meetings – normally 4 times a year, in the early evening - and take on particular additional tasks in relation to the work of the Governing Body.

Carrington School also has two sub-committees, Quality of Education and Finance and Resources, each Governor is assigned to at least one of the Committees also.
