Dear parents and carers

Following my [email on 20 January](#) we can now share with you the **final arrangements for your young person's mock exams** starting on 10 March.

Attached is a detailed timetable for the mock exams; this includes both core subject exams and option subjects that will be covered in each of the Option slots during the week. We encourage you to display the timetable at home so that your young person can easily refer to it and plan their study schedule.

Your young person's individual timetable is also now live on Arbor. While we are not planning on making any changes to this, there may be small changes to seating plans so please ensure your young person checks Arbor regularly during the exam period.

During the coming weeks we encourage your young person to review their notes, complete any outstanding assignments, and seek help from their teachers if needed.
