Here are some of the **key steps we will take** based on your feedback:

Parent Involvement

We will hold a parent focus group during the planning stages to ensure we address the information and communication that you need to support your young person's success.

Improved Communication

While the assessments were planned with a long lead time, we recognise that some parents did not receive timely communication about SKI Week. We will ensure that all relevant details are shared well in advance through clear and consistent channels.

Better Scheduling

To maximise preparation time, future SKI Weeks will not be scheduled immediately following extended breaks (e.g. October half-term, Christmas, or Easter).

Reinstating Pastoral Time

Daily pastoral check-ins with tutors will be reinstated to provide students with additional support and guidance.

Clarifying Revision Expectations

Revision guidelines will be shared with greater clarity via Arbor to help students and parents plan effectively.

Informative Webinars

We will host a SKI/Exams webinar in the spring term to explain the purpose of SKI Week and provide practical advice on how you can help your young person achieve their best results.

Additional Support for Key Stage 4

While we aim to promote independence and self-regulation among our Key Stage 4 students, we recognise that some would benefit from additional support. We will provide more contact time within the timetable to assist these students in their exam preparation.
