Apprenticeships are one of the options available to your young person when they leave School, but can also be accessed at any point in their working life. They are a great way into an area of work as they provide all the training and skills to ensure success.

Your young person will be learning all about Apprenticeships in their Personal Development lessons next week and Year 11s will also have an opportunity to attend a workshop in school on Monday to find out more about what an apprenticeship involves, how to search for one and how to make an application.
