Trip to See Charlton Athletic v MK Dons, 22 February

We have secured a limited number of tickets to take students to The Valley Stadium to watch **Charlton Athletic Vs Milton Keynes Dons** on **Tuesday 22 February** for a **19:45** kick off.

- Students attending will need to meet at school no later than 17:00 ready to depart by coach
- Once at the stadium and through the turnstiles, students will have the opportunity to explore the stadium and purchase snacks if they like, before watching the game
- We will be leaving the stadium at full time (21:35) and returning by coach to Noke Drive, arriving at approximately 22.45
- Please note that despite our late return students attending will be expected to attend school on Wednesday at the normal time
- Students can wear their own clothes for the trip but should not wear merchandise of other teams as we will be guests of Charlton Athletic, but local sides branding such as Merstham or South Park are permitted

If you'd like your young person to attend this, you can book a place by going onto [ParentPay](#) and paying **£12** to cover ticket and travel.

However, we know that the cost of this trip will prevent some from signing up.
